Manufacturer Sales Data (MDS) Program
DATA SHARING PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

The undersigned firm agrees to actively participate in the WASTEC Market Statistics Programs for which it is eligible in order to gain access to certain data from the Manufacturer Sales Data (MDS) Program of the Waste Equipment Technology Association ("WASTEC", or "The Association"), a part of the Environmental Industry Associations ("EIA"), in accordance with the following terms:

Section 1 -- Signed Agreement.

Participants must submit the signed original agreement prior to their gaining access to shared data from the MDS Program. The original signed agreement shall be submitted to the Waste Equipment Technology Association, 4301 Connecticut Ave., NW, Suite 300, Washington, DC 20008.

Section 2 -- Description.

The Production Statistics Program shared data report includes the product categories and subcategories authorized for data sharing by the WASTEC Board of Governors, as recommended by the Market Statistics Project Working Group (PWG). Bond Beebe, Inc. (hereinafter "the Administrator") collects, compiles, and reports data for all WASTEC Market Statistics Programs.

Section 3 -- Data Submissions and Sufficiency.

If in the professional opinion of the Administrator, the raw data submitted for a particular survey raises a question that may compromise the confidentiality of any member's data submission, then the Administrator will not release data, unless authorized in writing by the company affected by the confidentiality issue.

The member must initially submit two quarterly WASTEC Market Statistics Program surveys for all Programs in which it is eligible in order to receive MDS shared data reports, and must thereafter submit data each quarter in order to continue receiving these reports.

Section 4 -- Role of EIA/WASTEC.

WASTEC functions as the Market Statistics Programs coordinator between the Administrator and WASTEC's Market Statistics Project Working Group (PWG). Neither the Environmental Industry Associations nor WASTEC will have access to any raw data nor any report which has not been specifically authorized by the PWG. WASTEC may circulate certain summary data reports to members of the Association as specifically authorized by the PWG. The Executive Vice President of WASTEC will be permitted to know which companies are participating in the program and which companies are reporting in each category.

Section 5 -- Data Submission.

The undersigned firm agrees to submit data, for all WASTEC Market Statistics Programs in which it is eligible to participate in order to be entitled to the quarterly shared data reports from the MDS Program. The undersigned agrees to submit data on Quarterly Data Surveys as sent by the Administrator, including the WASTEC Industry Market and Production Survey(all members) and the MDS Survey (for members producing product covered by the various product lines in the program).

Members who are eligible to participate in the MDS Program as manufacturers of equipment in the various product lines must also complete a separate Agreement for that program.

Section 6 -- Eligibility.

The undersigned understands and agrees that participation in the WASTEC Market Statistics Programs is available only to WASTEC members. Participants will receive detailed reports only for programs in which they participate, and for only those data categories in the MDS Program which are authorized for data sharing. The undersigned agrees not to disclose voluntarily, or cause to be disclosed, the reports to any other company, agency, or individual that is not an eligible participant in the program. The undersigned understands and agrees that unless it submits all surveys each quarter, the WASTEC Market Statistics Project Working Group may review any circumstances to determine whether a company should remain enrolled in the program. Failure to maintain membership in good standing, or to report continuously in all WASTEC Market Statistics Programs for which the member is eligible, will terminate a member's privilege to participation in the MDS data sharing reports.

Section 7 -- Designation of Firm Representative Point of Contact.

In order to ensure program quality and continuity, the undersigned agrees to designate a primary company representative as the Point of Contact who will be responsible for regularly obtaining, reviewing, and submitting the requested data, and who will receive the data sharing reports from the MDS Program.. An alternate company representative also shall be designated. Both primary and alternate representatives shall have ready access to reliable data, be available to ensure that accurate data is provided in a timely manner, and shall have the requisite responsibility and authority to coordinate within and among company departments providing data, and with the Administrator and WASTEC Market Statistics PWG representatives.

Section 8 -- Program Continuation.

The continuation of the WASTEC Market Statistics Programs is contingent upon the recommendations of the Market Statistics PWG and approval by the Board of Governors of the Waste Equipment Technology Association.

Section 9 -- Dispute Resolution.

The undersigned agrees that any discrepancies or issues, if not resolved informally among participants, shall be referred in writing to the Chairman of the WASTEC Statistics Project Working Group for resolution, with a right of appeal to the WASTEC Board of Governors, whose decision and disposition will be binding upon the program participants.
