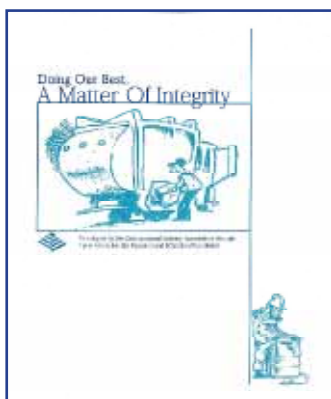


Manual of Recommended Safety Practices
